Master of Science thesis (1986): Petrologia e Geoquímica de rochas peralcalinas do Cinturão de dobramentos Cachoeirinha–Salgueiro, Nordeste do Brasil (advisor: Prof. A.N. Sial)

After finishing the M.Sc degree (1986), she went to the University of Georgia, at Athens, USA, earning the Ph.D. degree in 1991 working under Prof. J. A. Whitney advice. She was admitted as assistant professor in the Federal University of Pernambuco in August 1989. Currently, she is a full professor at this University where she teaches igneous petrology and high-temperature stable isotope geochemistry. She is responsible for the XRF laboratory and the CO₂ laser-based extraction line for silicates and oxides in the LABISE. Her research focus on Ediacaran granitoids of the Borborema Province, northeastern Brazil, and on isotope chemostratigraphy of Precambrian and Phanerozoic basins in Brazil, Argentina and Uruguay. Results from his research resulted in the publication of more than sixty scientific articles, mostly in international journals, which received over 800 hundred citations in ISI and Scopus.
