He is a petrologist and full professor at the Department of Geology, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur, India, who has visited the LABISE for three months in 1997 (TWAS fellowship), for one and half year in 1999–2000 and for three months in 2013 (both under CNPq scholarship). In all three occasions, he focused stable-isotope geochemistry on the study of carbonatites from India or to C, O and Sr isotope chemostratigraphy applied to the Paleoproterozoic, Precambrian–Cambrian transition and Cretaceous Paleogene (K–T) boundary.
